Earn a High School Diploma via the Safety Harbor Public Library by: Lisa Kothe, Library Director

Safety Harbor Public Library is offering qualified community members the opportunity to earn an accredited high school diploma and career certificate through Career Online High School, a program brought to you by the Florida State Library. The program is designed to reengage adults into the education system and prepare for entry into post-secondary education or the workforce. It is free for residents of Pinellas County who qualify. Students must be 19 or older and have a PPLC library card or be willing to obtain one.



The Library will screen and award scholarships for Career Online High School to eager learners who want to earn a high school diploma and advance their careers. Once qualified and enrolled, Career Online High School pairs students with an Academic Coach who offers ongoing guidance and encouragement, evaluates performance, and connects the learner with resources. Classes are led by board-certified instructors. Students have 24/7 access to the online learning platform. Coursework begins in one of eight high-demand career fields (from child care and office management to certified transportation) before progressing to core academic subjects. Students are able to graduate in as few as six months by transferring previously earned high school credits and have 18 months to complete the program.
