## Election News

An election will be held on Tuesday, March 13, 2018, for the purpose of electing Commissioners to Seat Numbers 1, 2 and 3, each for a three-year term. The Qualifying Period for candidacy in the March 13, 2018 Municipal Election begins at noon on Tuesday, January 2, 2018 and closes at noon on Tuesday, January 9, 2018. A candidate needs a MINIMUM of ONE HUNDRED (100) signed and completed Nominating Petitions submitted and verified before the close of the Qualifying Period. All Nominators MUST BE qualified electors in the City of Safety Harbor at the time the petition is signed. Candidate forms and information is available at the Office of the City Clerk. ## PENNY FOR PINELLAS

### REFERENDUM VOTE NOVEMBER 7, 2017

On Nov. 7, 2017, Pinellas County residents will decide on the renewal of the Penny for 10 years (2020-2030). The Penny makes it possible to do more capital projects without relying on property taxes. The Penny generates the equivalent of 2.4 mills of property taxes (\$314 on the average single-family home with a taxable value of \$131,000). Without the Penny, Safety Harbor would rely more heavily on other funding sources, such as property taxes, to fund capital projects. Without such funding, many projects would be delayed or deleted.

#### Christmas

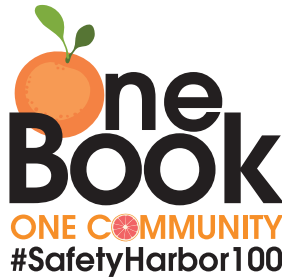

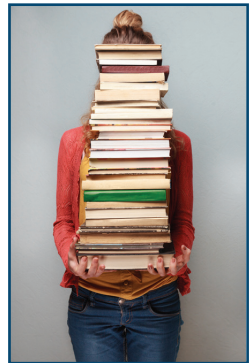
The One Book concept was created in 1996 to foster a shared love of reading within a community to read, discuss, and share the same book. Ms. McLain, author of the bestseller *The Paris Wife*, now returns with her new historical novel, *Circling the Sun*, transporting readers to colonial Kenya in the 1920s. *Circling the Sun* brings to life a fearless, captivating woman, Beryl Markham, a real life record-setting aviator caught up in a passionate love triangle with safari hunter Denys Finch Hatton and Karen Blixen, author of the classic memoir *Out of Africa*.

### Upcoming Pipe Lining & Drainage Improvement Projects:

Approximately 25,000 linear feet of 8 inch sanitary is to be lined within various areas of the city between November 2017 and May 2018. Lining of the pipe prevents groundwater infiltration and extends the life of the sanitary sewer system. Pipe lining is a viable alternative to repairing sanitary sewer lines without having to install new sewer lines by open cut that could have significant disruption to affected properties. The scope includes lining of approximately 500 linear feet of 48 inch storm sewer. A contract for drainage improvements along North Bayshore Drive at four intersections has been approved. Improvements to eliminate flooding will occur at Jefferson Street, Church Street, Tucker Street and Hillsborough Street. A schedule is currently being prepared for these improvements that are expected to commence in the near future.
