Free shade trees will be planted in applicant's front yards; providing shade and helping to beautify our neighborhoods and city. Once established, all provided shade trees are drought tolerant. Applicants are responsible for watering the trees during the establishment period. Staff will finalize the location, based on tree rooting area and the avoidance of utilities.

Planting Requirements:

- Trees to be planted only in front yard and not in a right-of-way
- 15' from powerlines
- 6' from sidewalk
- 10' from driveway
- 12' from other healthy shade trees

One tree per resident. Select first preference and a second should the first selection not be available.

- Southern Live Oak
- Gumbo Limbo
- Bald Cypress
- Eagleston Holly

Applicant agrees to water and maintain tree to ensure its survival and understands if tree dies the city will not replace it or remove it.

A water schedule and pruning guide will be emailed or mailed when tree is planted.
