Bill Cropsey Citizen's Academy

The City of Safety Harbor is now accepting applications for the 2019 - Bill Cropsey Citizen's Academy. Sessions are scheduled on Tuesday evenings from 6:00p.m. to 8:00p.m. and will begin on May 7, at City Hall. The Bill Cropsey Citizen's Academy takes place over a seven week period and will be limited to 20 participants. Academy applicants will be chosen on a first come, first served basis with preference given to Safety Harbor residents.

The Bill Cropsey Citizen's Academy will tour key facilities, learn about the challenges facing Safety Harbor, interact with City leaders, discover ways to get involved with local government, and learn about the essential functions of a municipal government agency.

Capital Improvement Projects Update

MLK Sidewalk at Folly Farms

A sidewalk extension on the south side of Dr. Martin Luther King Boulevard from Los Prados Condominiums to Folly Farms Park was completed in February 2019. A crosswalk with flashing beacons was installed by the entrance to Folly Farms to allow for a sidewalk connection to the north side of the road.

Waterfront Park Phase 2

Ornamental light poles and bollard lights are in the process of being installed along the 10-foot walkway on the west side of the park from North Bayshore Drive to Veterans Memorial Lane and along the sidewalks leading to the plaza. Bollard lighting will be installed along the perimeter of the plaza area. Work commenced in January and is expected to be complete in April 2019.

Plans for a living shoreline were sent out to bid on February 1. The living shoreline will be constructed in place of the dilapidated seawall and will consist of oyster bags on the toe of slope that will serve to provide wildlife habitat and to protect the shoreline from erosion, and a graded slope is to be planted with native vegetation. A spring feature will be constructed along the shoreline that will be fed by the overflow of spring water from the Safety Harbor Spa.

Sugar Bear Drive Sanitary Sewer Improvements

Installation of 210 linear feet of 8 inch gravity sewer line on the north end of Sugar Bear Drive in the Briar Creek subdivision is to commence in March 2019.

Scott Street Sanitary and Storm Sewer Improvements

Installation of 30 linear feet of 30 inch storm pipe and 50 linear feet of 8 inch gravity sewer line in Scott Street north of 4th Street South is expected to commence in March 2019.

Inflow and Infiltration Smoke Testing


McKim and Creed Engineers will conduct smoke testing of various sanitary sewer lines throughout the city in February 2019 for the purpose of identifying storm drainage systems connected to the wastewater collection system. Removal of those connections will reduce the amount of flow being treated at the wastewater treatment plant and result in a cost savings to the city.

North Bayshore Gravity Sewer and Force Main

Construction of a 6 inch force main along Church Street from Philippe Parkway to North Bayshore Drive and of 8 inch gravity sanitary sewer on North Bayshore Drive from Church Street to Hamilton Street will commence in March 2019.
