



Library Foundation Let's Build a Story Fundraising Plans

As the library continues to attract high numbers of visitors, organizations, and businesses due to its cultural and educational programs, vast resources, and convenient meeting areas, it's no surprise the library's current space cannot keep up with demand.

For the past several years, the Safety Harbor Library Foundation has been fundraising to support the City's construction of a second story meeting room facility for essential items from furniture, to audio visual equipment, a stage, hearing loop, podium and more. Fundraising will continue until their goal of \$500,000 is reached or exceeded. To date, approximately \$175,000 has been raised. Architectural design planning will begin this fiscal year providing a visual concept for the public. Construction is slated to begin mid-2021.

Highlighted 2020 fundraisers include partnering with Birdies for Tampa Bay Charities, Christiana Drapkin and the La Lucha Band on January 30, the 2nd annual Links for our Library, a mini-golf pub crawl on February 8, Casino Night in April, Watermelon Week and Jazz on the Waterfront in May, and the 3rd Annual Cupcake Contest in October. Other events are in the planning stages.

City of Safety Harbor Notice of Election Candidate Qualifying Period

City of Safety Harbor, Florida, March 17, 2020 Municipal Election

In accordance with the City Charter and Chapter 6 of the City Code, the Municipal Election of the City of Safety Harbor will be held on Tuesday, March 17, 2020 in the City of Safety Harbor between 7:00 a.m. and 7:00 p.m. This Municipal Election will be for the purpose of electing Commissioners for the Mayor-Commissioner and Seat #4 for three (3) year terms.

The candidate "Qualifying Period" shall begin at 12:00 p.m. on December 2, 2019, and shall end at 12:00 p.m. on December 9, 2019.

A candidate needs a MINIMUM of ONE HUNDRED (100) signed and completed Nominating Petitions submitted and verified before the close of the Qualifying Period. All Nominators MUST BE qualified electors in the City of Safety Harbor at the time the petition is signed. Candidate forms and information is available at the Office of the City Clerk.
