

To help us provide safe and efficient sanitation collection service to the community, the City of Safety Harbor Sanitation Division request that you follow these procedures:

1. Carts and bulk must be curbside ready for collection no later than 6:30AM on collection day.
2. The cart handles should face your house with the opening facing the street.
3. Keep the lid closed and do not overfill.
4. Multiple carts should be positioned with 3 feet space between them with no overhead obstructions.
5. Carts cannot be blocked by parked cars, mailboxes, low-hanging trees, fencing, etc. Blocked containers will not be emptied.
6. If you move, please leave your carts at your old home for the next resident to use.
7. Non-City issued cans are utilized in Mobile Home Parks (MHP) and can be used as part of the 10-item bulk pick-up. Cans shall not exceed 32-gallons in size or 40 lbs. weight.

## Trash

Your trash cart is for household trash and yard waste collection. Garbage is collected once a week. Please fill this cart prior to placing bulk. \*

**DO NOT** place the following in green carts:

- Automotive batteries
- Concrete
- Construction debris
- Fluorescent bulbs
- Hazardous waste (products labeled as toxic, poison, corrosive, flammable or irritant)
- Hot ashes
- Infectious waste (including needles)
- Oil
- Paint
- Pesticides
- Recyclables
- Tires

## Recycling

Your recycling cart is for recyclable materials (*please see the list below of acceptable items*). Don't forget that every ounce counts!

### Recyclable items include...

**REMINDER: Please do not put trash in the recycling or yard waste bins.**

Recycle clean, dry plastic bags & wrap at a facility or store. Plastic bags and plastic wrap are **not accepted** in the curbside recycling program. Return these items to a local grocery store.

## Yard Waste

Yard Waste is collected in your automated can, 32-gallon cans, or in tied bundles (4 ft. long) at the curb on your garbage day. Do not place yard waste on storm drains, on sidewalks, or in the roadway. \*

### Yard waste items include...

- Branches
- Brush
- Grass Clippings
- Leaves
- Palm tree trimmings
- Tree trimmings

### Non-acceptable materials...

- Animal waste
- Cactus
- Construction debris
- Garbage
- Plastic or paper bags
- Contractor/Lawn Maintenance Debris

\*Maximum of 10 bulk items/bags per garbage day. Any bulk item not collected on your garbage day can be picked up by special pick-up. Yard waste special pick-up is also available. Beginning October 1, 2022, household electronics such as flat screen TVs, CPUs, Video Game Units, Laptops and Tablets (batteries removed), and cell phones (batteries removed) can be discarded with residential garbage. Larger items that do not fit in the City issued will count toward the 10-item bulk limit. Contact Public Works for special pick-ups (additional fees may apply).
