

To Obtain CDL:

1. Go to DMV website and get CDL handbook. <http://www.flhsmv.gov/handbooks>
2. Study
3. Go back to DMV and take permit test...
 - a. In regards to Medical Cards: mark exempted unless driving for SHARP
Non-exempted interstate (medical card needed) – this is needed for child care licensing.
Exempted interstate (no medical card needed)
4. Pass with flying colors.
5. Arrange practice time for you to drive with our CDL Drivers.
6. Call to book a test date/time... Driver must call as they need your information. You must have permit for 14 days prior to taking the test. Ask for price of test and get a check request done.
