



Florida Fall Photography Contest

Contest Rules and Regulations

We want you to show us what the subtle signs of the changing Fall season look like in Florida. All images must be taken within Florida during the Fall season. Please note location and approximate date on the entry form.

This contest is open to amateurs only and all entries must be the original work of the submitter. For the purpose of the contest, an amateur is defined as one whose primary source of income (>50%) is not derived from photographic work.

Only Pinellas Public Library Cooperative library card holders are eligible to enter the contest.

The contest has no entry fee and is open to all ages.

Prizes

Winners will receive a gift card to a Safety Harbor business. The prize values are as follows:

1st prize: \$50 gift card

2nd prize: \$25 gift card

3rd prize: \$15 gift card

Submissions

Digital submissions will be accepted online only from November 1 to November 30, 2020. Limit one (1) original photo submission per person. Submissions of more than one photograph will be disqualified. Submissions must be in JPEG or PNG format, and files must be no larger than 50 MB. Please submit the highest resolution possible while staying within these parameters.

If a photograph is deemed inappropriate, it will not be entered into the contest. All accepted contest entries may be displayed on the Safety Harbor Public Library's social media. Contestants authorize the use of their submissions for any promotion and advertising at the discretion of the Safety Harbor Public Library.

Judging

Photographs will be judged by library staff the first week of December and winners will be announced by 12/7. Winners will be contacted via the email address or phone number provided on the entry form.
