


## Q1 Do you live in Safety Harbor?




## Q2 Do you work in Safety Harbor?


















## Q14 Regarding the existing poles and banners at the 10th Ave and Main Street gateway, would you prefer:





## Q17 Do you enjoy outdoor seating on the Main Street sidewalk at restaurants and bars?



## Q18 What type of seating would be your preference:




