


Q1 Do you own a business in Safety Harbor along the Downtown Main Street Corridor?












Q6 Would you support design of new Gateway monuments at the entrance to downtown Main Street at 10th Avenue and Philippe Parkway?







Q10 If the City were to add a graphic map/directory sign to be placed in downtown with directional graphics to businesses and destinations, would you prefer it to be located:


